

### Questions you're afraid to ask!

**Q:** Halleluja, I am getting a tax refund this year! What numbers do I put down for my checking or savings account so the IRS can deposit my money faster with no hassle?

A: The numbers you give to the "tax person" for your refund are very important. If you want the refund in your checking account then look at your personal checks. The first group of numbers on the bottom, left hand side are your Routing and Transit Numbers for WSCU, 307076724. The next set of numbers in the center is your checking account number. The last set of numbers you need to <u>ignore</u>, as they are the actual number of the check you are looking at!

Here is how it breaks down at a glance:



If you want your deposit to go into your regular savings account, then provide WSCU's routing number and your member number.

#### Don't Let Checks Bounce Because of Reg D

Regulation D is a federal regulation that requires WSCU to limit the number of withdrawals from non-checking accounts without a signature. You may have up to six withdrawals or transfers in each savings, money fund, holiday or vacation club account per month.

#### This includes:

- HomeLink (online banking)
- DataCheck (telephone banking)
- Overdraft transfer from savings
- Phone requests
- Automated clearing house (ACH)
- Check card transactions

Regulation D limitations **do not** include the transactions that are:

- Completed in person
- Signed transfers by mail
- Transfers to a WSCU loan
- Signed night drop requests
- Requests for a WSCU official check payable to you

Failure to observe Regulation D limits will result in items being returned. (bounced checks!) For more information on Regulation D, go to: WeldSchoolsCU.com

## **Mobile Banking**

#### There's an App For That!

WSCU has a mobile app for Apple or Android. Download the app to your smartphone or tablet. Stay connected to your WSCU accounts.

With Mobile Banking, you can:

- •Quick balance view account balance without logging in
- •View running transaction balances for accounts
- •Access each share account
- •View posted and pending transactions
- •Transfer funds from Share accts.
- •Find a surcharge-free ATM
- •View graphs of spending patterns and balance patterns
- Let your Credit Union know you will be using your WSCU debit/ credit card out of town
- •Keep a close eye on your accounts to avoid/detect fraud
