



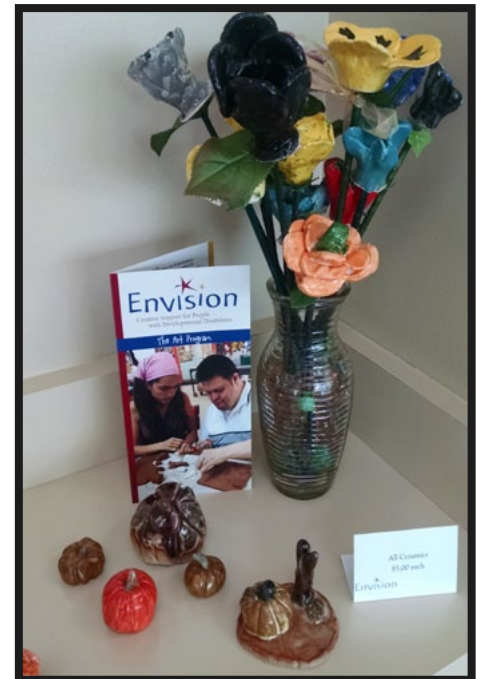

Phishing - Don't Get "Hooked!"

How can you prevent 91% of hacking attempts on your home or business computer?



As of 2016, 91% of malware and hacking attacks on organizations came from people clicking on links in an email. This can also effect people at home. Think about that for a minute,... over 90% of hacking can be easily avoided!

"Phishing" is the term for this type of lure, and the fix is simple: when there is

something in an email you want, and it involves clicking on a hyperlink in the email, instead, open a browser such as Internet Explorer or Chrome without using the link, and go to the website directly to find the resource you want.

In general, you should never click on a link in an email. A phishing email is copied and will likely look exactly like an email you normally expect to receive, (think Lands End or Sears) and the website it takes you to will appear to be a website you expect to see.

The outcome of clicking on a link can be very harmful. Attacks might steal your credential information used to log in on websites, or plant a virus on your hard drive. Even if you don't think you have important information on your computer, it can make your computer a hub for illicit activity or reach out through your email to your contacts, take over your facebook or worse.

So if you want to see the latest and greatest buys at Best Buy, do NOT click through the email they sent you. Just open a browser and go to Best Buy's website, go forth and be safe!



Pennies From Heaven Youth Service Project

If you're looking for a unique and fun service project for your students this school year, we hope you will encourage them to participate in our Pennies from Heaven campaign to support the youth programs of The Community Grief Center.



Not only will this campaign help Weld County kids who are grieving the death of a loved one, it will also create math learning opportunities for your participating students and reward them for participating.
