The personal info of millions of people may be at risk, and the bureau has set up a system to check to see if you're at risk. If the test at [equifaxsecurity2017.com](http://equifaxsecurity2017.com) tells you you're at risk, the bureau offers a free credit monitoring service. You should also consider placing a credit freeze or fraud alert on your
