Weld Community Credit Union is pleased to inform you that your deposit accounts at Weld Community Credit Union are now insured up to \$500,000. This exceptional level of coverage is attained through a combination of federal insurance provided by the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) and private insurance

from Excess Share Insurance Corporation (ESI).

All individual savings, checking, and certificates of deposit accounts held by the same member are added together and insured up to \$250,000 by NCUA plus an additional \$250,000 from ESI, for a total of \$500,000.

Joint accounts and IRA accounts are insured in the same manner as above and are insured separately.

This insurance is provided to all Weld Community Credit Union members at no extra cost to you.
