Call wait times will be longer than usual as more people call in, and so we thank you in advance for helping us to cheerfully serve you.

We have cancelled the Members Annual Meeting and Shred/Electronics Recycling events in April. Once we have a new date for the Members Annual Meeting, we will let you know and publish it in this newsletter. We do not currently plan to re-schedule the shred and recycling event this year.

Please watch out for fraud. As a reminder, under no circumstance will we call you and ask for your social security number, user name, password or PIN. Be aware that criminals may use this time to scam people. If you receive a call from anyone asking for this information, even if it appears to be from our credit union, do not provide it. Criminals are able to make our phone number appear on your caller ID even though it is not us calling. *If you call us; however, then we will ask account identifying information.*

Alternately, if you receive a text, email or phone call from our fraud center asking to verify purchases, please do respond. They will simply ask you 'yes' or 'no' to verify purchases, and in doing so, you will allow your card to remain active. You will know it is our Fraud center contacting you because they won't ask for information beyond verifying 'yes' or 'no' to transactions, and you should not provide any information beyond that.

Thank you for being a member and rest assured we are monitoring and adapting to this situation as needed. We will take every measure to limit the impact on our employees, members and help stop the spread of Coronavirus in the community.

Take a Break with SKIP-A-PAY

Weld Community Credit Union invites you to "take a one-month break" from your loans with SKIP-A-PAY.

- Log into WCCU's HomeLink (online banking site) to do this: go to the services tab, scroll down to SKIP-A-PAY. Qualified loans will be listed. This is how to get Skip-A-Pay for all non-mortgage loans.
- For home equity and mortgage loans call the Credit Union and ask for Skip-A Pay at least 7 days in advance of your payment due date.

It is that easy! So just give yourself a break!

Please note: SKIP-A-PAY adds the payment skipped to the end of your loan, interest still accrues, and skip a pay decreases GAP coverage by the payment amount; however, there is no extra fee!
