There is LIFE after LAWN

With just over 13 inches of rainfall per year, Greeley is considered a semi-arid climate. This means local water supplies are precious and must be used wisely. To help customers save water outdoors, Greeley provides a variety of water conservation programs.



Weld Community Credit Union (WCCU) wanted to save water by xeriscaping a large swath of land, and found the Life-after-Lawn rebate program with the City of Greeley Water/ Sewer department. The Life-after-Lawn rebate is a strong incentive for residents and businesses within the city to remove healthy, irrigated grass and replace with Colorado natives or xeriscape plants that use very little water through a drip system. When fully grown, these xeriscape plants need to provide 50% of the green-space, in order to qualify for the rebate.



WCCU removed 10,000 square feet of sod, and replaced it with a wandering stone stream bed, stone bench, boulders, and numerous Colorado native plants and pollinators that provide a visually interesting curb appeal.

When asked why Weld Community Credit Union took on this large project, CEO Dave Brown stated, "We want to be good citizens in the community and reduce our water usage."

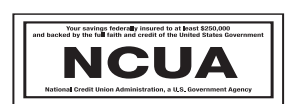
