Please do not trust someone who calls you on the phone and starts demanding money, saying they are the IRS, they're holding a relative in jail, there is a lawsuit pending against you or something else. If they call you, it is certainly not the IRS because they do not call people, and if they say they are holding a loved one, simply let them know you'll need to check on that. (Even if the caller begs you not to!) Above all, be on the guard for anyone asking for your account number. As soon as they ask for your account number, you know it is a scam.

It's also important to respond to calls where our fraud center is calling you to verify recent transactions on your card. You'll know it's our fraud center because they are <u>not</u> going to ask you for your account numbers, but will want to verify recent transactions. I repeat, they will <u>not</u> ask you your account numbers or social security number.

Remember, if someone is pressuring you for money or to put money into gift cards such as itunes or google play to give to them, let us know. Call us, come in and see us, ask us, because we're here for you, and this is one of the more important ways we can help.
