A Letter From Your CEO

Hello Everyone,

Over the last year, we have reviewed our water use and found ways to become a better steward of this resource. We realize that while it is nice to have a large green lawn, you will be just as happy with us if we scale back. Studies show that approximately 50% of residential water is used in watering lawns, and given the use of the building, our percentage is probably higher than that. Last year we took the first step by installing Xeriscaping along the south side of the building, which comprises about 1/4th of the irrigated lawn area. This year we have focused on water use audits to ensure water is not being wasted within the building, and we have continued to fine-tune and repair the existing sprinkler system to improve efficiencies wherever they could be found. During this review, we ended all outdoor watering on the west side of the building, and stopped watering plants in the middle of the parking lot. Next year we will continue making improvements, because the conservation of water is an issue that affects us all.

In addition, over the last few years, we have also cut our electrical consumption with the installation of high efficiency lighting indoors and outdoors, and we are careful to control the nighttime use of energy when we are closed. These positive steps fit into our greatest goal: to be able to serve you well with friendly service and great loan rates, while at the same time partnering in the needs of our community.

The Marketing team was invited and attended staff meetings for: Fort Lupton School District RE-8; Highland School District RE-9; Roosevelt School District RE-5J; and Eaton School District RE-2. They also attended Greeley-Evans School District 6 School Kick off as well as Meeker Elementary Back to School night.

As the team talked to educators and parents they stressed the importance of financial literacy and getting additional funds in the classroom.

Zogo - Free digital/mobile app for high schoolers through adults to download. It is a gamified way to learn financial literacy in bite-sized chunks. As they answer questions and go through the modules, they earn pineapples to turn into gift cards. So you can earn while you learn. Try it! Download Zogo free from an app store, use code: WELD

Education Assistance Fund (EAF)- Weld Community Credit Union (WCCU) donates funds to go into the classrooms for projects or supplies that their school can't fund. Any educator can apply for these mini grants. The process is simple and the application can be found at <https://weldccu.com/forms-and-applications/>. WCCU has given over \$135,000 back to the Weld County classrooms one small grant at a time. \$300 is the grants average. Possible grant ideas are classroom libraries, 30 copies of a book for a common read, STEM kits, or math manipulatives.

The deadline for EAF application is October 15th.
