The Jeri Cranwell Education Assistance Fund (EAF) is a long tradition with Weld Community Credit Union (WCCU). Over the years WCCU has given over \$153,600 to Weld County Classrooms one mini-grant at a time.

The EAF was designed to help educators pay for projects in their classrooms instead of the educator paying for it out of their own pocket. For a long time, one had to be a member of WCCU in order to benefit from this fund, however the committee chose to change this rule a year ago. The grant is open to any classroom, whether the educator is a member or not. The EAF committee wants to take care of the education community. This is another example of the credit union philosophy of "People Helping People".

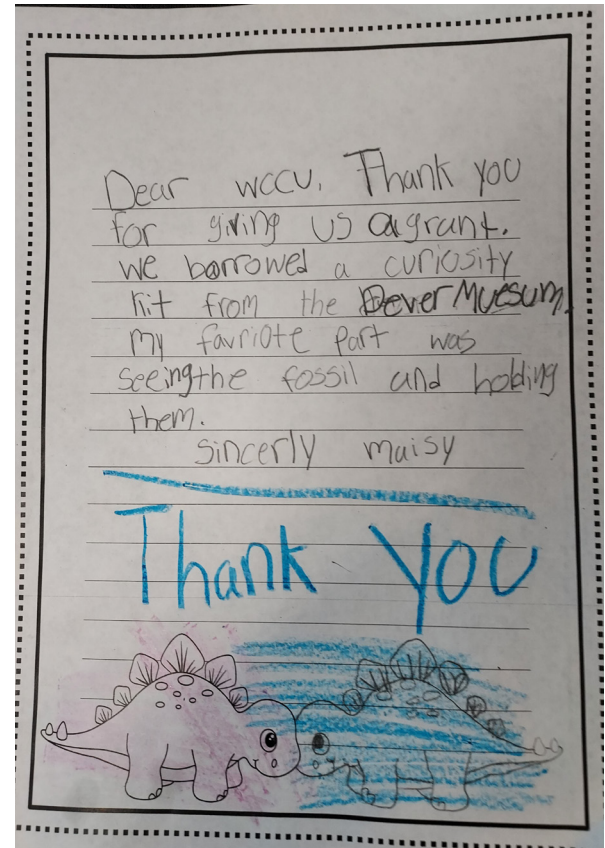
