Please let us know!

When you travel out of town, state or country, please notify Weld Community Credit Union and let us know where, when and what Weld Community Credit Union cards (debit or credit) you will be using.

You may notify us by calling at (970) 330-9728 or you can go to our mobile app, click on the 3 horizontal lines, go to Card Controls, click on the card you will be using, click on Schedule Travel, and enter your travel dates.

We are not being nosy, or keeping track of you. We want to make sure there are no fraud warnings with your card and for you to enjoy your travels.

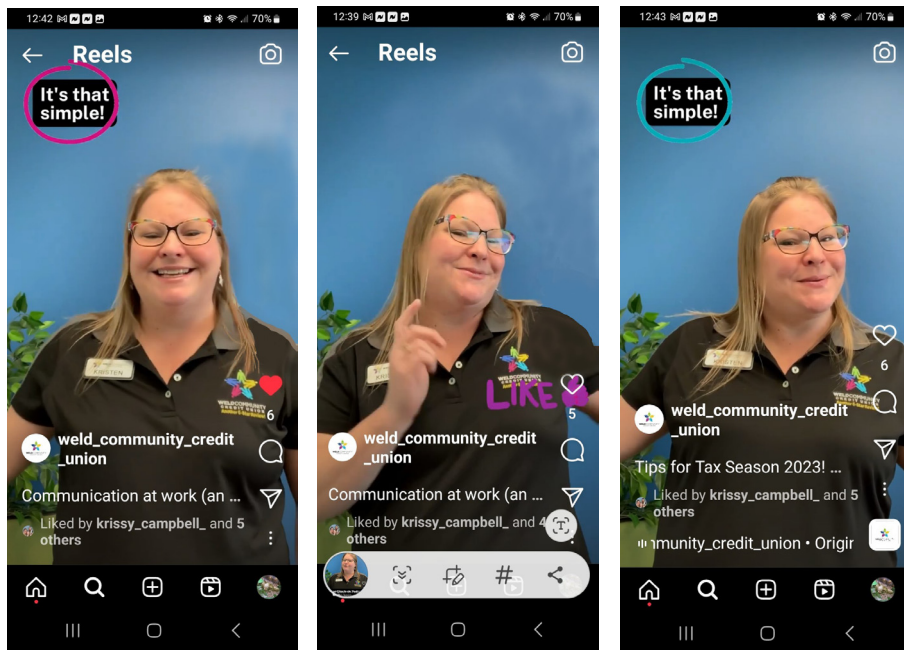
Dormant Account

Please remember to make at least one transaction on your savings and checking account once a year. A \$3.00 per month Account Inactivity Fee is charged when there is no transaction of any kind posted on a member account for one year. This fee is waived under the following circumstances:

- Member is under the age of 18
- Member has a certificate of deposit
- Member has an active WCCU loan account
- Aggregate of all shares accounts=\$250.00 or greater

However, if an account does not show activity in 5 years, WCCU must close the account and send the funds to the Colorado Department of Treasury Unclaimed Property Division (The 'Great Colorado Payback' Program).
