<u>Make a sock puppet!</u>

Making a sock-puppet is a fun budget-friendly summer activity to do! It encourages creative thinking by using simple craft supplies and a sock to make a puppet. Once finished, you can spend time making up a character, a voice, and a personality for the puppet. Then you could put on a puppet show, or have your puppet read one of your storybooks out loud!

Here are the supplies you'll need to make a sock puppet:

- Socks
- Hot glue gun (parental supervision)
- Scissors
- Craft Supply ideas:
 - Felt
 - Needle/thread
 - Yarn
 - Rickrack
 - Pipe cleaners
 - Buttons
 - Craft poms







- **1.** Put the sock on your hand to get a feel for where the mouth will be.
- **2.** The mouth will be created by the crease between your fingers and thumb.
- **3.** Once you have a feel for how you want to hold the puppet, mark where you want the eyes to go with a marker.
- **4.** Use googly eyes, pompoms or buttons for the eyes to give your sock puppet a face.
- **5.** Use hot-glue to attach different craft supplies to the puppet to add hair, accessories, or even hands!


Use your imagination to create a unique puppet! Be careful however! Hot-glue can be HOT! So make sure an adult is present when making this particular craft.
