The Three Jars

There are three basic places that your money should go: **Spending**, **Saving**, and **Giving**.

The best way to see where your money should go, is to create a visual system for dividing your money into these categories. Here is a three jar guide to help.

You can use any type of money holder you want. Use something you can see through and something that you can not open easily. Maybe you have piggy banks, clear cups/jars with lids, or even closable plastic bags. You can be creative and label them with the three categories.



SPEND: If you have money you get to spend it on the small things you want. As long as your parent(s) approve. This is also the stepping stone to get you to a bigger goal and start saving.



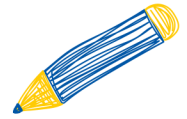
SAVE: This is where you put the money you want to save for a goal amount you can reach quickly. Is there something you have wanted but you did not have enough money for it? If yes, you can SAVE until you have the money to buy it!



GIVE: Generosity is as simple as giving money to church or Sunday school, or setting aside money for a charity that you like. This will help you learn how good it feels to give. Consider asking your parent(s) to take you to a food bank or a similar organization where you can see your donation doing good for others. This will instill a sense of goodwill and purpose that will motivate you to contribute a portion of your money to the "give" jar.
