## Don't Get Stung by Fraud

The fraudsters are out in full force, Weld CCU wants to protect you! When you call in to transfer money and make payments, you may be asked as many as 5 questions about your account that only you will know. If you are on mobile banking, Weld CCU staff will verify who you are by sending you a code through text.

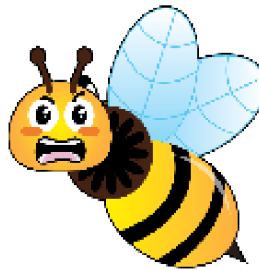

## Don't Get Stung by Fraud

If you call us, we may send a verification code to your phone to make sure it's really you.

If you do a transaction with a WeldCCU employee, on mobile or online, it may send a verification code to make sure it's really you.



### However: Don't Share Your Verification Code!

2-step verification is when our system sends a text message to your phone to help complete a transaction, to keep your account safe. The purpose of this system is to verify we are truly working with You and no-one else. If you share the code with anyone, think of it as giving them full access to your account, and all of the money in it can be theirs.

### Don't trust caller ID – be cautious when receiving calls

Scammers can make any number they want to appear in your caller ID. This is called “spoofing”, and it allows them to call you with a fake phone number and fake caller ID. They might say all the right words to sound like us, so don't rely on caller ID as proof of who is calling—it can be fake. We will never call you then ask to verify a code. If someone calls and asks for information, it's a scam and you should hang up, even when it looks like we are calling.

### Don't share your code: If you call us, it's good. If they call you, it's bad.

Verification codes and other ways to access your account are only for you. If someone calls and asks for your verification code that we send, it's a SCAM! Hang up and don't share any private information. Giving someone that code is the very same as giving them all the money in your account!

### BOTTOM LINE

1. If you call us, we may send a verification code to your phone to make sure it's really you.
2. If they call you and ask for a code however, it's a scam!

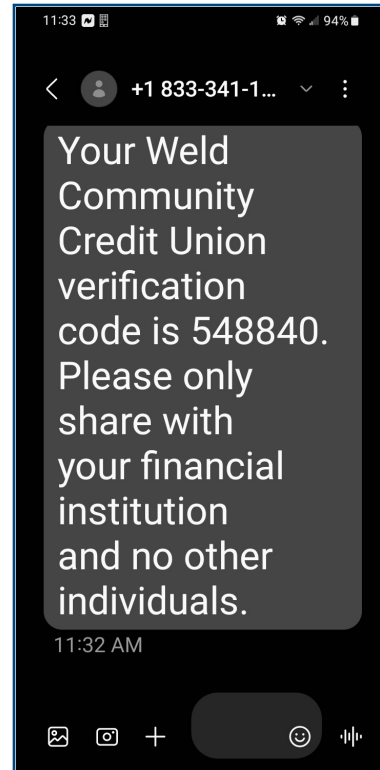
When in doubt, hang up.

If a phone call seems weird or Fishy (phishy), it probably is. Just hang up and call us!

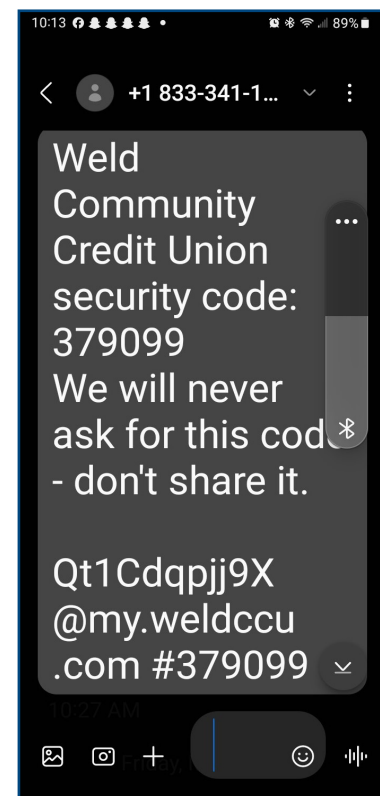
